OVER-PRODUCTION/CONSUMPT ION The world has production capacity enough to feed 9,500 million (9.5 billion) people*.

The current world population is 7,500 million (7.5 billion) people, and from those, **750 million (10%)** go to bed hungry.





FOOD INSECURITY

Today's **agro-industry** has become a business which cares more of generating money, not food. And the food that it produces is mostly not nutritious. **Most of the food in the market is junk food.**

Food security happens when three things are met:

- Availability
- Accessibility
- Biological use
