Orphaned by the death of mother and/or father

Sadness	Confusion
Loneliness	Rejection
Anger	

Orphaned by the intentional abandonment of the parents

Feelings	Attitude
Sadness	Rebellion
Abandonment	Confusion
Rage	Shyness
Guilt	Rejection
Anger	Dissatisfaction



b. Characteristics of the orphans through their socio-economic status

- Dependance on someone who is not a parent
- Early involvement in child labor activities





c. An orphan's alternatives in life

- Live in solitude
- Take responsibility for younger siblings.
- Live with a foster family
- Live in an orphanage





d. Risks and dangers for an orphan

- Abandonment of studies
- Repeat the cycle of orphanhood because of the abandonment



- Involvement in drug or other addiction
- Early death
