Christ in the Bible

- Mark: Proclaim! Accomplish God's will!
 - Christ is the Prophet of God
 - Christ is the Servant of Jehovah
 - Mark 10:45
 - Mark 16:15-16
 - Mark 13:10

Christ in the Bible

- Matthew: Royalty, authoritative Kingship
 - Christ is a royal king with authority
 - Christ has the full authority of the God of creation and history
 - Matthew 9:6
 - Matthew 12:8
 - Matthew 26:64
 - Matthew 28:18-20
 - Matthew 13:37, 41
 - Matthew 16:27
 - Matthew 24:30

Christ in the Bible

- Luke: Amplifies Christ as priest and Savior
 - Examples of how we should follow in service
 - Luke 5:24
 - Luke 6:5
 - Luke 9:26
 - Luke 10:9 – Preach and heal!
 - Luke 19:10
 - Luke 21:27
 - Luke 22:69

Christ in the Bible

- John: Christ is the Word, the Light of the world
 - Christ's position as eternal Son of God
 - Christ coequal and coeternal with the Father
 - John 3:16-17
 - John 1:29
 - John 4:42
 - John 6:33
 - John 8:12
 - John 9:5
 - John 12:46
 - John 16:8

Christ in the Bible

- John: Christ is the Word, the Light of the world
 - Christ makes redemption possible
 - Holy Spirit involved in redemptive relationship
 - John 16:8
 - John 12:32

Salvation is experiencing Christ

- John 1:12
- 1 John 5:12
- Romans 8:32

Salvation: by grace alone!

- By His power and grace
 - Ephesians 2:4-6, 8
- Through being united with Christ
 - Galatians 2:16

Missions: Two Mandates?
