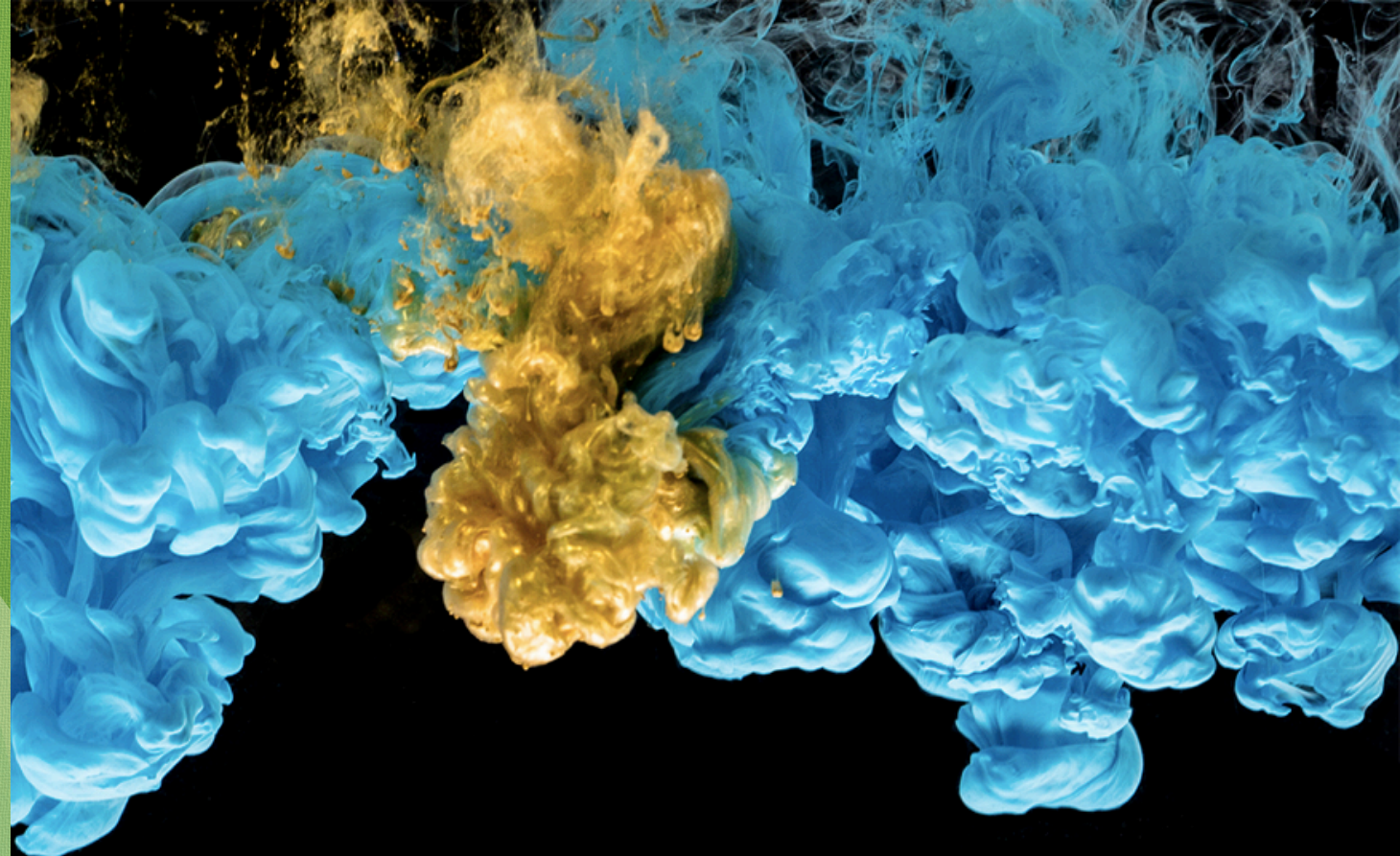

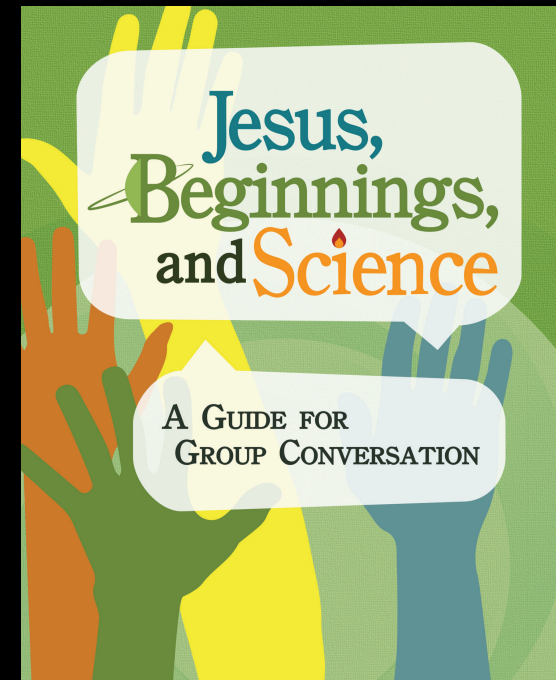




Hebrews 1:1-3a
