## Know your context!

- Number of internationals on your campus
- Location where internationals gather
- Staff and faculty who work with internationals
- Interview some internationals:
  - What is their experience like?
  - What are their needs?



### **International Conversation**

#### What to ask?

- Where they are from
- What they are studying
- What their spiritual background is
- Questions about family
- Ask: "What is life like in ...." Instead of "Do you have TV in your country"




### **Cross Cultural Basics**

I have become all things to all people so that by all possible means I might save some. I do all things for the sake of the Gospel, that I may share in its blessings.






## **Role Play**


### **Gender Boundaries**


#### What now?




