“Big Ideas” of leader training

1. God-size vision for a movement
2. Disciples not Converts
3. Love God and love neighbor
4. Person of Peace
5. No follow-up = no discipleship
6. Groups not Individuals
7. Every generation has 4 generations
8. A lot of prayer
9. Word of God focus, not teacher focus (“Teaching is for leaders”)
10. Open the conversation, don't close the conversation
11. Tell what Jesus did in your life (testimony)
12. Become like the people you want to reach
13. Church is the people, not the building
14. Look for Barnabas and be Paul to him
15. Hear, obey, and speak God's Word
16. Biblical leadership = upside down kingdom
17. Develop thousands of leaders
18. Exchanged life
19. Show your character in the home
20. Reconciliation by confession and forgiveness
21. Prepare for persecution
22. Right verses at the right time (to emphasize importance of verse lists)
23. Unknown health is bad health (to emphasize importance of knowing health of generations beneath you)
24. Know your grandfather and grandson (to emphasize importance of multi-generational relationships)

Future Emphasis

Disciple apostolic team!

- They meet 4x per year, Keith is with them 2x per year
- They appoint and disciple elders by location as appropriate, yearly visitation trip 2x2
- They disciple the second generation of apostles
- No new leader discipleship by along-siders—this is all done inside DF
 - 3 leader trainings planned for this year
- Keith uses whatsapp for more leader development, relationship, less travel
- DE-emphasize data tracking—“Day of Discovery”
- Discipling the Elders well
- Marriage and relational health
